

How to Re-line a field

1. Paint sheds have a combination lock. 4-4-0-6

Push up against shackle. Lock will pop open. (Change numbers and close shackle to close lock.)

2. Get a striping machine and several cans of paint.

3. Shake. Shake some more. Then shake again. When you think you've shaken enough - shake some more.

4. Invert can and slide can into striper. Line up can nozzle with groove in sprayer. Practice someplace AWAY from your field, and see if your stripe is at least 3" wide. If not, adjust can in groove until you get a WIDE stripe.

5. Go to your assigned field. Line up striper over previous lines....and paint away. Take your time. (A full sized field can be re-lined in 20 minutes...so this won't take long.)

6. Paint over all the lines, the corner arcs, the penalty box, the goal box, the center circle, the penalty arc, etc.

7. Return striper and unused paint to paint shed. If you have a partially used can of paint, turn it right side up - and spray till clear (couple of seconds). This keeps the paint from clogging the nozzle.

8. TAKE THE EMPTY CANS TO THE DUMPSTER. IT'S LESS THAN 10 STEPS FROM WHERE YOU ARE.

9. If you like your work, brag about it. If you don't,blame it on another team.
